

Yardwaste will be picked up on your regular trash day. Please have curbside prior to 7AM. Place leaves, grass clippings & twigs, (less than 1") into brown paper leaf bags, or open barrels, no lids please. Plastic bags will be rejected curbside, but can be emptied out at 225 Plain St. (Compost Site). Branches & shrubs can also be brought to Plain Street. Open April - January, Wednesday through Sunday--7:15 AM-2:45 PM. Trash sticker required--may be obtained at the Collector's Office at Town Hall (781-794-8130).
