IMPORTANT FEE CHANGE NOTICES (EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024)

TRASH DEPOSIT STICKER

Braintree's blue trash deposit sticker for use at the Recycle and Compost Centers will expire June 30, 2024 and beginning July 1, 2024 Braintree residents must possess a new white sticker for access to these locations. Also, beginning July 1, 2024 Braintree will charge a **\$25** fee for every sticker issued and a sticker will no longer be included in the curbside trash collection fee. Stickers can only be issued to residents who provide proof of an active vehicle registration in Braintree. To obtain a new white sticker, residents can visit the Water & Sewer Department at 85 Quincy Avenue or the Collector's Office at Braintree Town Hall, One JFK Memorial Drive.

CURBSIDE TRASH COLLECTION

Braintree's curbside trash collection fee will be **\$200** per residential unit for the year (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025). A **\$55 senior discount** is also available for eligible residents.

ONE LOAD PERMITS for the year (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025) are **\$50** per load.

COMPOST BINS for the year (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025) are **\$60**.

ADDITIONAL TRASH and RECYCLING CART for the year (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025) are **\$100** per each additional trash and/or recycling cart. Proration of this fee will still be permitted based on date of purchase.

IMPORTANT SERVICE CHANGE NOTICES (EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024):

TRASH FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Beginning July 1, 2024 the curbside trash collection fee will be billed with Braintree's Water & Sewer bill and can be paid quarterly along with your Water & Sewer payment. Payments can be made online at <https://www.braintreema.gov/784/pay> or in person at the Water & Sewer Department at 85 Quincy Avenue or the Collector's Office at Braintree Town Hall, One JFK Memorial Drive. If paying in person, please bring your bill.

MATTRESS and BOX SPRING CURBSIDE COLLECTION SERVICE

Beginning July 1, 2024 Braintree will no longer offer curbside collection of mattresses and box springs. All residents needing to dispose of mattresses and/or box springs can utilize one of several private sector vendors offering this service. TRASH OPT-OUT OPTIONS

Beginning July 1, 2024 the only curbside collection opt-out program will be the complete opt-out. To qualify for a complete opt-out option, a resident must possess a valid contract for trash and recycling collection at the address listed on the bill. The contract must be with a trash company permitted by the Board of Health, pursuant to Chapter 5.50 of the Town's bylaws and MGL Chapter 111, Section 31A-31B and must cover the period July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. To apply, residents must provide a copy of their valid contract to the Water & Sewer Department or the Collector's Office **ON OR BEFORE THE BILL DUE DATE**.
