 Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC
 Weymouth Compressor Station (Transmittal No. X266786)*

Dear Mr. Cushing:

Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (Algonquin) was issued Air Quality Plan Approval - Transmittal No. X266786 (the Plan Approval) by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) on August 26, 2019. The Plan Approval authorizes the construction and operation of the Weymouth Compressor Station, 54 Bridge Street, North Weymouth, Massachusetts.

As part of activities associated with placing the compressor station into service, there will be natural gas released as the station piping is gradually pressurized. The activities are scheduled to occur December 4th through December 11th. Employees are expected to be on site on Sunday, December 6th to monitor the system, but no work will be occurring that day.

In accordance with Section 3.B., Table 11, Condition 2 of the Plan Approval for the Weymouth Compressor Station, Algonquin is required to notify MassDEP prior to any scheduled gas releases at the Weymouth Compressor Station that are expected to exceed 10,000 standard cubic feet (scf) of natural gas. The estimated total volume of natural gas anticipated for release between December 4th and December 11th is 60,270 scf, as outlined in the table below.

If Algonquin revises its timeline for these scheduled natural gas releases, Algonquin will promptly inform MassDEP.
